

ASD ASSESSMENT



Initial Consultation

Initial consultation involves a screening assessment using a variety of tools such as the Social Communication Questionnaire (SCQ) + the Autism Diagnostic Interview-Revised (ADI-R) with the caregiver.



Observation Assessment

The next session involves an observational play or activity-based assessment using the Autism Diagnostic Observation Schedule, Second Edition (ADOS-2), a semi-structured, standardised assessment of communication, social interaction, play, and restricted and repetitive behaviours.



Observation Assessment

The child is then observed in at least one additional setting such as their daycare; and additional information about their communication, social interaction, and behavior is collected from their educational and therapy providers.



Diagnostic Report

Clinician collates the above assessment data into a diagnostic report. In addition to information relating to an ASD diagnosis, the report outlines strategies for addressing any challenges highlighted by the assessment.



Pricing Information Child

Initial consultation, as well as a follow up appointment to discuss the assessment are bulk billed.
